

Viacheslav Shelepov

The Russian-born pianist Viacheslav Shelepov graduated from the Academic Music College (Moscow) and Moscow Tchaikovsky Conservatory, the Faculty of Historical and Modern Performing Arts. His tutors included Alexei Lubimov, Alexei Shevchenko, Maria Uspenskaya, and Sergey Kasprov.

Apart from the piano, he also plays period instruments. In 2018 he received a Master's degree in Fortepiano in Hannover University of Music, Drama and Media, under the guidance of prof. Zvi Meniker with whom he is currently studying harpsichord.

Viacheslav is the laureate of many competitions such as:
